

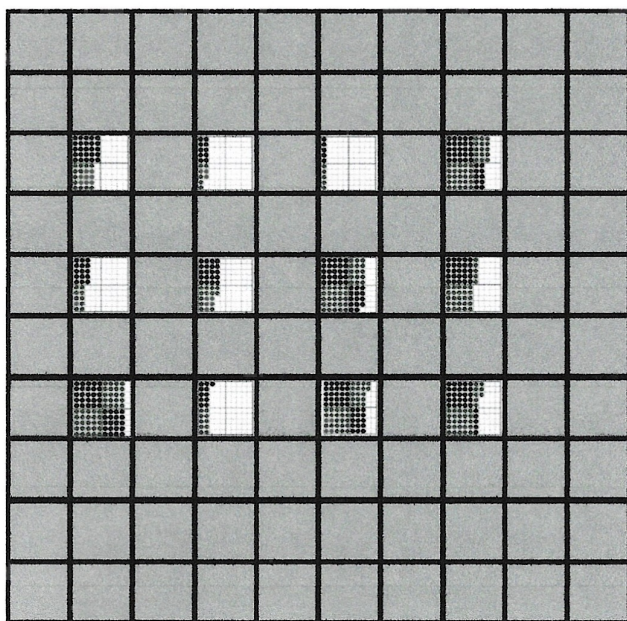
## Pick Two

**Purpose** to add two-digit numbers

**Materials** Place Value Cards  
The Learning Carpet

### Directions

Choose 6 card pairs that add up to 100 (45/55, 37/63...). Mix them up and put them face up on the carpet in rows. Each player estimates and chooses two cards they think will total 100. **Tell your thinking: I chose 45 and 55. 55 plus 5 makes 60. 60 plus 40 makes 100.** The player removes the cards from the carpet if the answer equals 100. Play continues until all matches have been made. Mix up the cards and repeat.



### More Ways to Play

Use *PreK-2 Structure Cards* and pick two cards to make 20 to add support.

Use math tools (popsicle sticks, frames or cubes) to add support.

Use *Place Value Cards* that add up to 30 or another decade to change the play.

Use 3 *Place Value Cards* to make 100 to add challenge.

Use *Number Cards* to add challenge.
